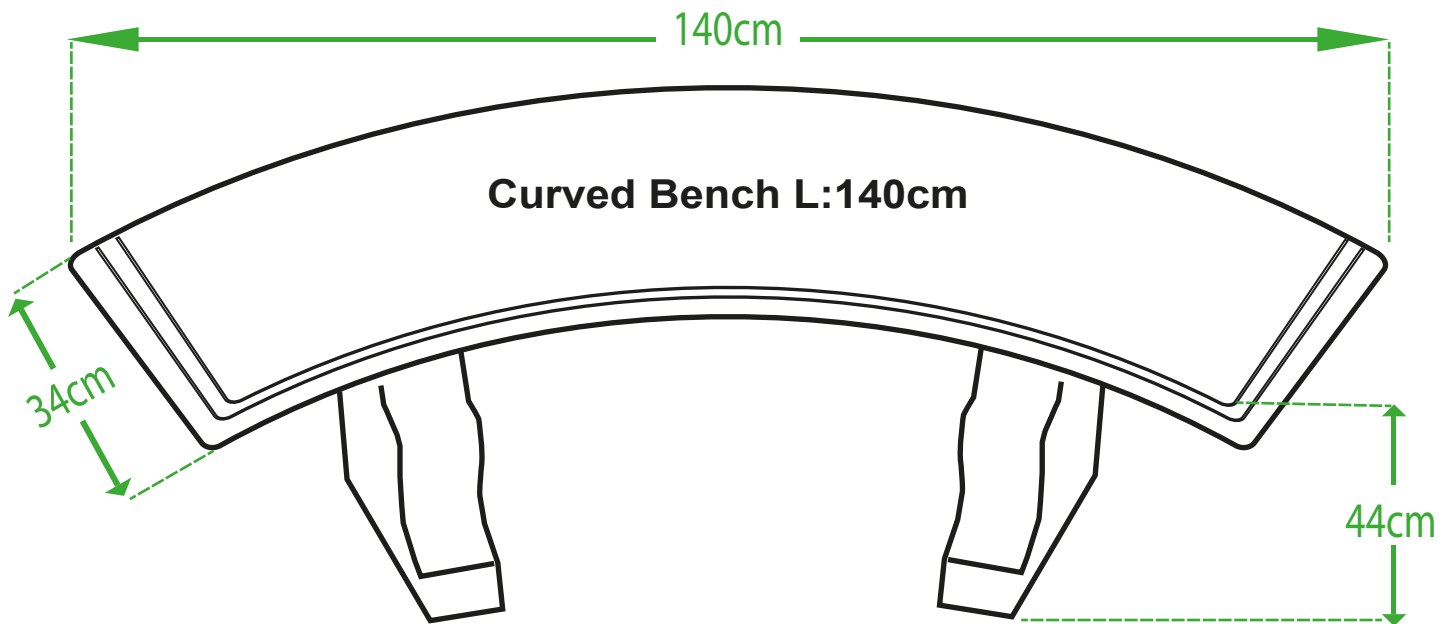

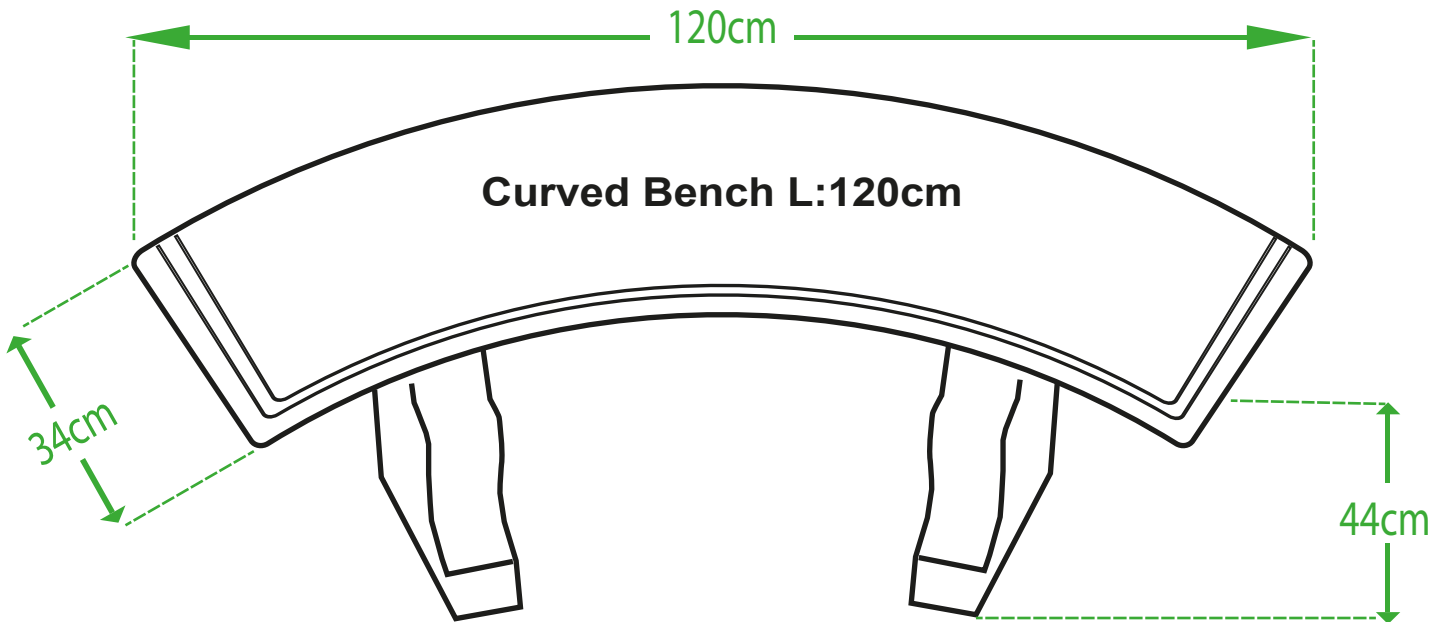

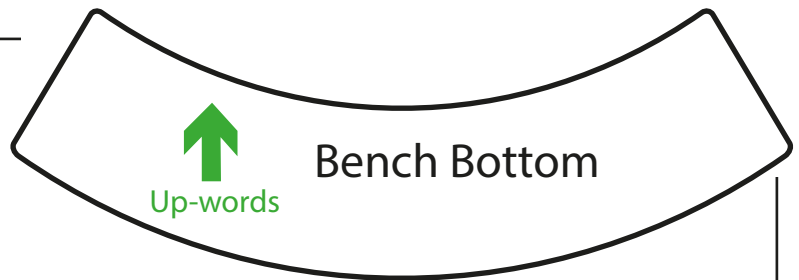

Curved Bench Assembly Guide

Setting up your stone bench is a straightforward process, but since stone is heavy and permanent, precision is key. Follow these steps for a secure and professional finish.

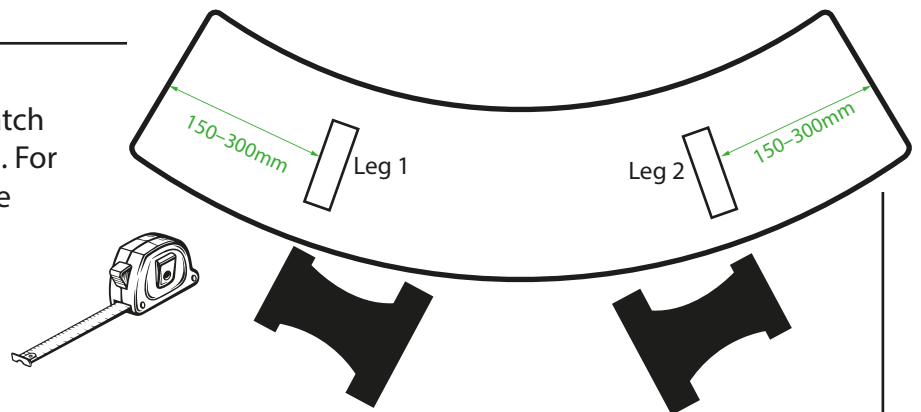
Step:1

Preparation: Lay the bench top on a flat, level surface with the bottom side facing upward. To prevent scratching the polished surface, we recommend placing it on a piece of cardboard or a soft cloth.



Step:2

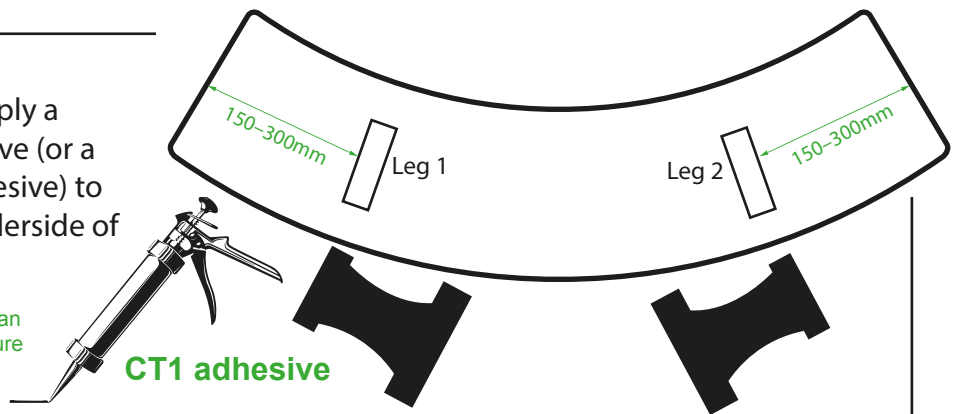
Alignment: Position the legs to match the natural curvature of the bench. For optimal stability and aesthetics, we recommend placing the legs 150–300mm in from each edge.



Step:3

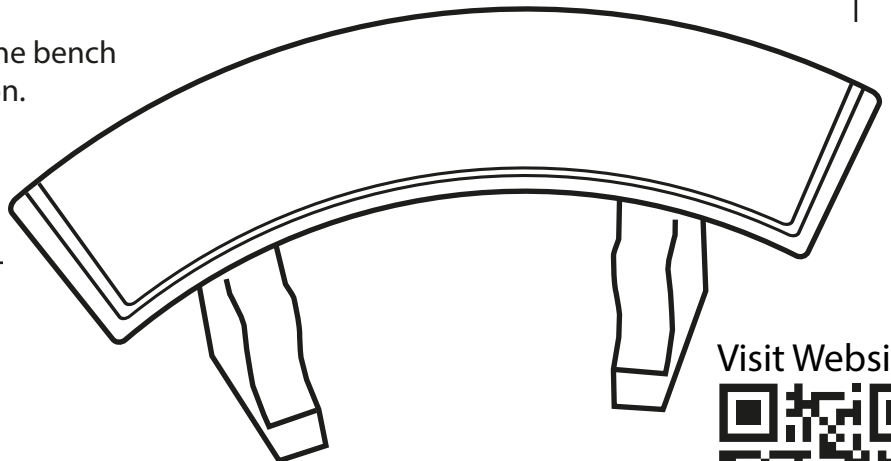
Adhesion: To secure the legs, apply a generous amount of CT1 adhesive (or a similar high-strength stone adhesive) to the designated areas on the underside of the bench top.

The adhesive is fully weather-resistant and can be applied outdoors. Allow the adhesive to cure undisturbed for 24 hours.



Step:4

Final Setup: Once dry, carefully flip the bench over and move it into its final position.
